EVENT INFORMATION

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1 ELIGIBILITY

1.1 The Tournament is open to all members of ESU.

2 OBJECTIVE

2.1 This programme is organised for ESU members to foster comradeship and maintain the spirit of goodwill, friendship and sportsmanship. The Tournament shall be conducted in accordance with Singapore Bowling Rules and Regulations and Safe Management Advisory. All team members are urged to ensure that bowlers played in the spirit of the game as provided in the rules.

3 REGISTRATION OF TEAMS

3.1 Registration forms with full payment of registration fees by PayNow to be submitted to ESU. PayNow Code and UEN Number as below: -\

3.2 Registration Fee is \$10 per single bowler. Registration Fee of \$50 for trios are Branch Fund payable.

3.3 For team event (Trios), at least one team member must be an ESU member and the other two may be immediate family members of the registrant. In this case, the full amount of \$50 is payable by the member through PayNow and is not claimable by Branch Fund.

3.4 Results of non-ESU members of the team event are not considered for the Singles Event.

4 FORMAT AND PRIZES

- 4.1 The tournament is played in Trios and Singles format.
- 4.2 Prizes will be given for top-5 Teams; top-3 Individual High Series (Male); top-3 Individual High Series (Women);
- 4.3 Each team will be made up of THREE (3) members and can have any mixture of male and female bowlers.
- 4.4 Female bowlers will be given a handicap of 10-pins per game (a total of 30 pins for 3-game series).
- 4.5 Each bowler will bowl a 3-game series and the total pinfalls (including handicaps) shall be used to determine the winners in Team and Individual prizes.

5 VERIFICATION OF SCORES

- 5.1 It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify the correctness of each game bowled by checking on the monitor console at the end of each game. Any incorrect score(s) displayed should be reported to the Tournament Officials or the bowling counter staff immediately.
- 5.2 After completing the games, bowlers will need to track their own scores.

6 TIES

- 6.1 In the event of a tie in the Team Event, the highest game in the team will determine the tie-breaker. Should the difference tie again, then the next highest game will be utilised.
- 6.2 In the event of a tie in the Individual High Series, the highest game bowled will determine the tie-breaker. Should the difference tie again, then the next highest game bowled will be utilised.

7 DISQUALIFICATION

- 7.1 Any form of cheating or manipulation of scores will render immediate disqualification of the bowler from further participation in this event.

8 INTERRUPTED GAME(S)

- 8.1 The Tournament Official may authorize the completion of a game or series. An important game/series that cannot be completed must resume from the point of interruption.

9 BOWLING ON WRONG LANES

- 9.1 When a bowler bowls on the wrong lane(s) and the error is discovered before the opposing bowler has bowled, a dead ball shall be declared and the bowler(s) will be required to re-bowl on the correct lane(s). If the error is not discovered until the opposing bowler has bowled, the scores shall count and the bowler shall be required to bowl his/her subsequent frame(s) on the correct lane.

10 PROTESTS AND APPEALS

- 10.1 Protest(s) involving eligibility must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Officials before prize presentation commences.
- 10.2 Protest(s) involving errors in scoring will only be entertained if such protests are brought to the attention of the Tournament Officials/bowling centre on the spot. The Tournament Officials/bowling centre will correct errors in scoring or in calculation immediately.
- 10.3 Protest(s) involving fouls must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Officials/bowling centre before the delivery of the next ball. No protests will be entertained after the bowler has made his/her second delivery of the frame.

11 OTHERS

- 11.1 The Organising Committee reserves the right to make changes to the Rules and Regulations of this event if it is deemed necessary.
- 11.2 Tournament officials may conduct checks on all bowlers' particulars (Staff Pass and/or Identity Card).
- 11.3 The Union, Organising Committee, Tournament Officials and Orchid Bowl will **NOT** be held responsible for any theft of belongings, injury or death whatsoever caused arising from participation in this tournament.
- 11.4 If any delay or postponement of the tournament occurs as a result of circumstances beyond our control, the Organising Committee's decision as to when the tournament will resume will be treated as final.

12 SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES ADVISORY

- 12.1 All bowlers must be fully vaccinated
- 12.2 During the bowling session, mask must be on at all times
- 12.3 Food and Drinks are allowed at the designated area
- 12.4 No intermingling between groups is allowed

13 COLLECTION, USE AND DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL DATA

- 13.1 Orchid Country Club and/or ESU will be retaining the data for the purpose of registration and participation in the above event
- 13.2 Orchid Country Club and/or ESU will be taking photographs during the event for news and publicity and may be used for print and on online/electronic platforms.
- 13.3 Where bowlers do not wish to be photographed, bowlers are required to notify ESU and/or Orchid Country Club during the event.
